Although it may go unnoticed, such needs often involve some text mining processes. The goal of this special issue is to solicit papers showing recent advances and applications in text mining. Prospective authors are invited to submit their works to this special issue. Subjects of interest include, but are not limited to:

- . Text (spoken or written) segmentation, summary extraction, keyword identification, indexing
- . Topic detection, taxonomy (ontology) generation, term clustering, document categorization
- . Web mining, patent mining, business mining, trend mining based on texts
- . Bioinformatics, scientometrics, webmetrics
- . Social network analysis based on textual information
- . Visualization and applications of text mining in various domains
